Psi Chi Application Instructions

Applications must be received no later than 5pm on the first Friday in February. Late applications **will not** be accepted. Applications should be left with Dr. Ilyse O'Desky (EC230B) on the Union campus. If they are not available, simply slide the application under the office door. Kean-Ocean students can turn in applications to Dr. Janine Shannon or Dr. Jane O'Brien.

Applications **will not** be reviewed without a current Program Evaluation for undergraduate students or an unofficial copy of your transcript for graduate students. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that applications are complete when submitted. Students **will not** be notified of incomplete applications but can submit a new application for the next induction ceremony if still a Kean student.

When listing the Psychology courses taken at Kean, do not list courses in progress or courses taken at other institutions. Instructions for calculating a Psychology GPA are included with this application. Please follow these instructions when completing the application. Your overall GPA is listed on the Program Evaluation.

Notification of acceptance into Psi Chi will be sent via mail. Please only include a valid address on the application. If your address changes after you submit the application, you must notify Dr. Ilyse O'Desky no later than the second week of February as notification of acceptance will be sent to email on file during the last week of February. Applicant notifications that went to the wrong address because of applicant error will not be included in the induction ceremony.

NOTES FOR THE PSI CHI APPLICATION
HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR GPA
IN PSYCHOLOGY COURSES

EVERY GRADE HAS A VALUE :

A=4 A-=3.7 B+=3.3 B=3.0 B-=2.7 C=2.3 C-=2.0 D=1.0

IF ALL OF YOUR CLASSES ARE 3 CREDIT CLASSES

ASSIGN THE CORRESPONDING VALUE TO EACH OF THE GRADES FOR ALL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES TAKEN AT KEAN. ADD UP ALL THE VALUES AND DIVIDE BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CLASSES. THE RESULTING NUMBER IS YOUR GPA IN PSYCHOLOGY.

EXAMPLE:

PSY 3110	A (4)	PSY 3200	A-(3.7)
PSY 2110	A-(3.7)	PSY 4200	A-(3.7)
PSY 3540	B+(3.3)		

TOTAL VALUE = 18.4

DIVIDE BY 5 (NUMBER OF CLASSES)

GPA = 3.68

IF EXPERIMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY (4 CREDITS) IS AMONG THE PSYCHOLOGY COURSES ON YOUR LIST

ASSIGN THE CORRESPONDING VALUE TO EACH OF THE GRADES FOR ALL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES TAKEN AT KEAN. NEXT, MULTIPLY THAT VALUE BY THE NUMBER OF CREDITS. DO THIS FOR EACH COURSE. ADD UP THE RESULTING PRODUCTS AND DIVIDE BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PSYCHOLOGY CREDITS LISTED. THE RESULTING NUMBER IS YOUR GPA IN PSYCHOLOGY.

EXAMPLE:

PSY 3110	A (4 X 3 CREDITS) = 12	PSY 3200	A-(3.7 X 3 CREDITS) = 11.1
PSY 2110	A-(3.7 X 3 CREDITS) = 11.1	PSY 4200	A-(3.7 X 3 CREDITS) = 11.1
PSY 3540	B+(3.3 X 3 CREDITS) = 9.9	PSY 4230	B+(3.3 X 4 CREDITS) = 13.2

TOTAL VALUE = 68.4

DIVIDE BY 19 (TOTAL NUMBER OF CREDITS)

GPA = 3.6
